



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1799 for the Selling certain Reserved tracts of land therein named, the Instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot No 7 of the reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County. Containing One hundred & forty nine Acres & One hundred and thirty six perches strict measure.
