



In pursuance of a Law passed 11<sup>th</sup> April 1799 for the Selling of certain Reserved tracts therein named the Instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General there upon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot Nº 16. of the Reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County Containing One hundred and forty nine acres & one hundred and thirty six perches strict measure.
