



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11th Day of April 1799 for the Sale of certain Reserved tracts of Land therein named, the instructions from the late Governor dated 14 May 1799 and the order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18th May 1799 Surveyed the 26th day of Sept: 1799 the above Described tract of land being Lot No 17 of the reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County. Containing Fifty six Acres & one hundred & forty eight perches strict measure.
