



In pursuance of a Law passed 11<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1799 for the Selling of Certain Reserved tracts of land therein named the Instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot No. 20 of the Reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County Containing Ninety four Acres & thirty Six perches strict measure.
