



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 1st April 1793 Surveyed the 2^d December 1796 to George Koch the above described tract of land situate in Allen Township Northampton County containing One hundred and thirteen acres fifty eight perches & the allowance of six p. Cent &c^a

In the General Draft made by James Scull for the Division of the Dry land tract the above described tract is called W^m Allen's land in the Proprietaries Original Draft of the 8000 acres it is part of the Dry Land. There is about 12 acres cleared on it by Laurence Brader, John Hynshaw, Peter Kehler & Stephen Jacob Mack who live on the adjoining tracts
