Asurveyed for Jeremiah Tallman Esquire on the 5th day of August 1844 by Virtue of an Order of the Board of Property granted on the 15th day of May 1844 and a warrant granted to Peter Housel on the 18th day of September 1794. Containing Two hundred and Sixty three acres Eighty six perches with allowance of six per Centum for Roads &c.
