



A draught of a Tract of land situate on the waters of Little Fishing Creek above & adjoining land of William Hall in the County of Northumberland - Survey'd in the year 1774 by Charles Lukens which appears by his Field Works, in the Hand ~~writing~~ of Jonathan Lodge assistant to said Lukens at that time, and Resurvey'd by me agreeably to the old Lines on the 22^d day of December 1790 for David Hall in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the 29th day of November 1774. Containing Three hundred & Thirty six acres & three quarters with allow- of six p Cent for Roads &c.
