Survey'd on the 4th day of April 1775 by Charles Lukens the then Deputy Surveyor of the District, & Resurvey'd by me on the 20th of November 1786 for David Franks by virtue of his warrant bearing date the third day of January 1775. Contain- ing Three hundred and Thirty two acres & the allowance of six p. cent for roads &c.
