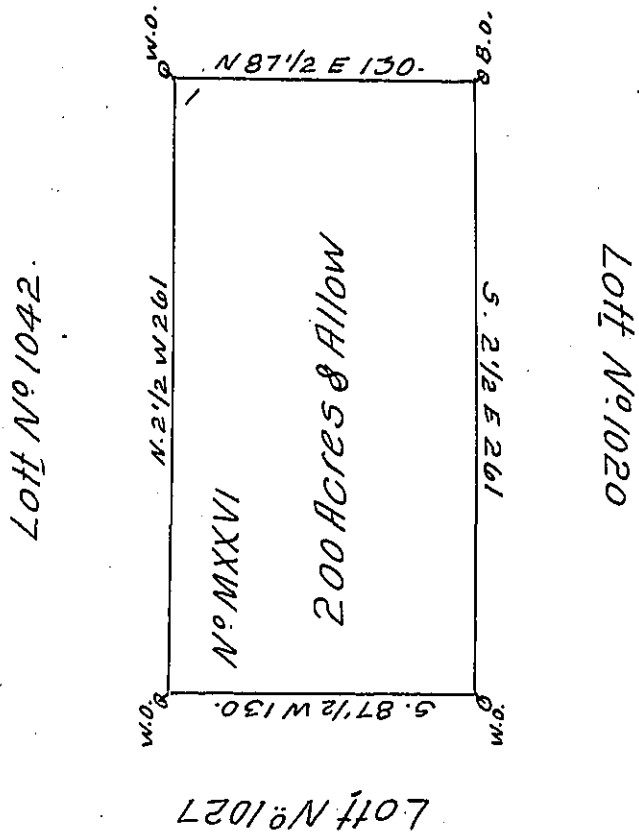


District No 6



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785, entitled an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth; and by Order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785. the above Discribed Tract of two Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six p<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads &c. No MXXXVI. Situate in District No 5. on the West side of the Allegany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
