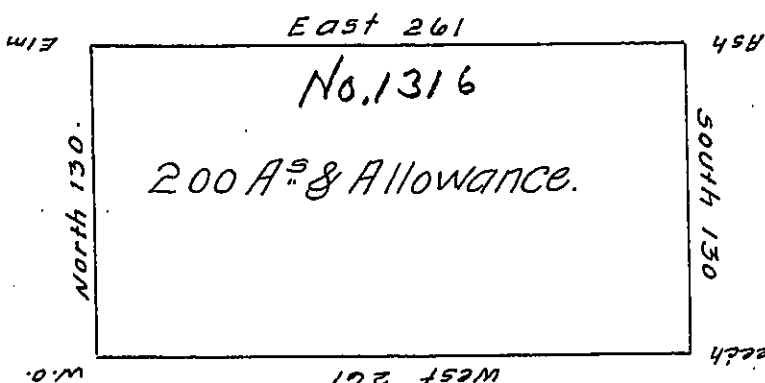

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania<sup>nia</sup> passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785. Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>o</sup> the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785. the Above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> DCCCXVI. situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Allegeny River in the County of Westmorland.
