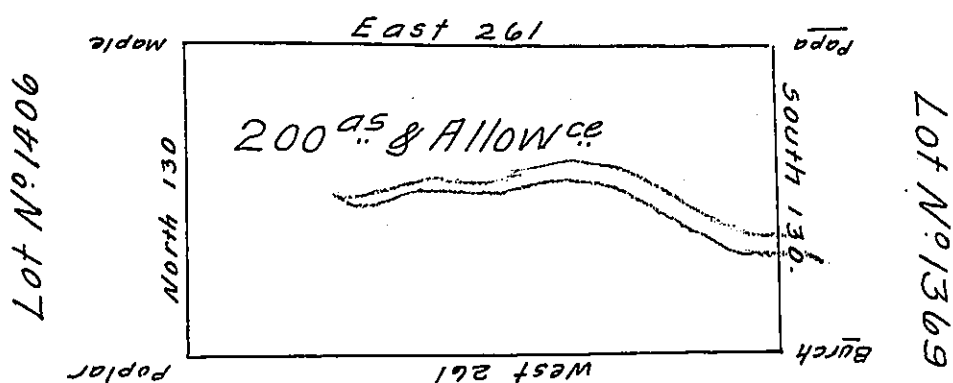

I have surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1785. the Above Discribed tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MCCCXC. situate in Dist<sup>r</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Allegheny River. In the County of Westmorland
