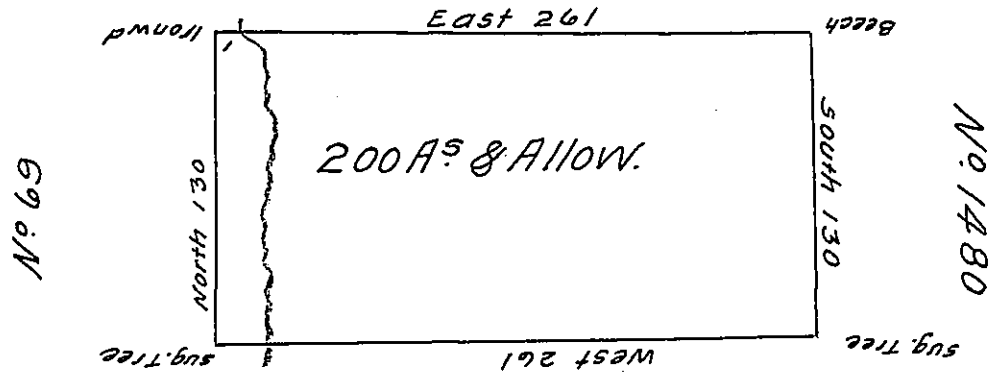

In pursuance of an Act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the State of Pennsylv<sup>a</sup> passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Febuary 1785. Intituled An act for directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the Ap<sup>ro</sup>bation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Sep<sup>r</sup> 1785. the Above Discribed tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c N<sup>o</sup> MDV. situate in Dist. N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
