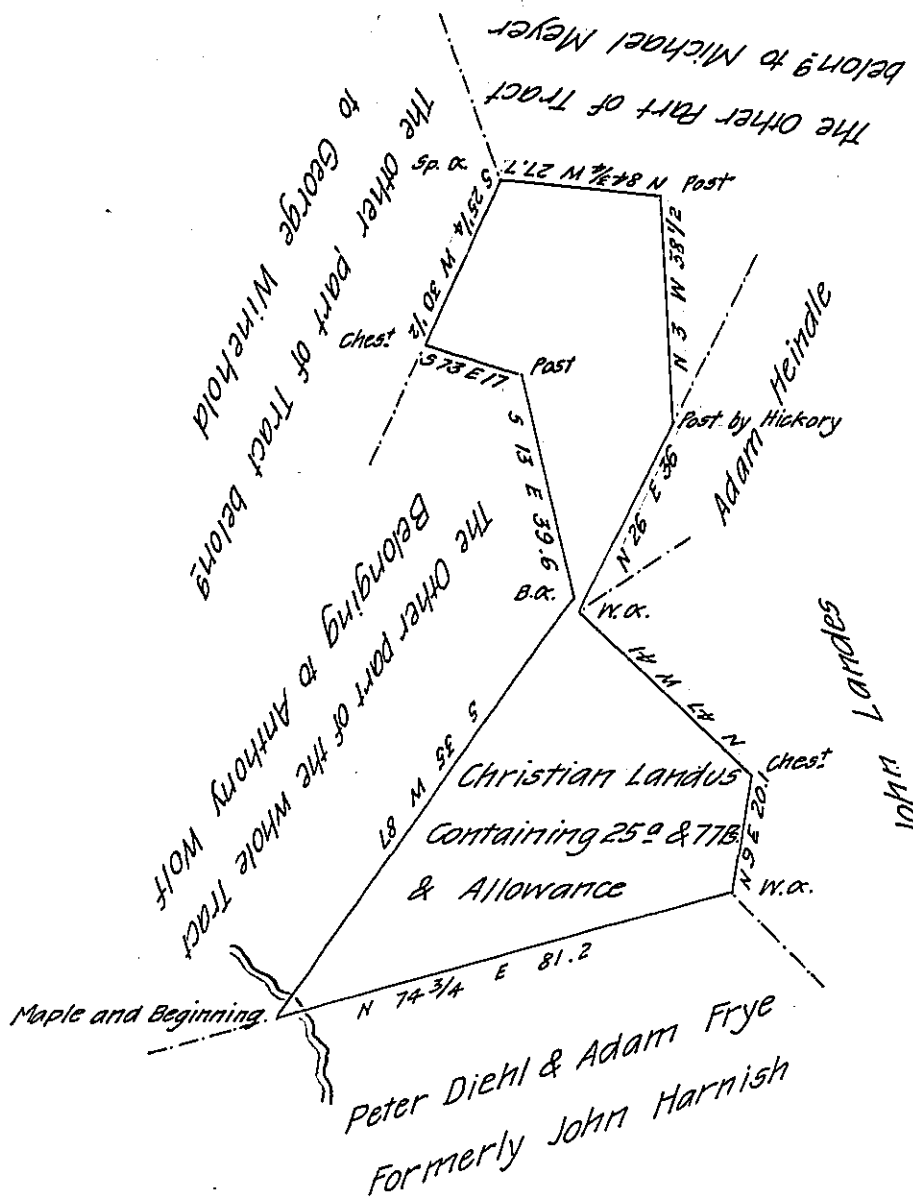


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 25.9 & 77 Perches and Allowance - Being part of a Tract of Land which was originally surveyed on the 11th day of the 4th Month 1767 by William Matthews late D.S. in Pursuance of a Warrant to agree for 200^a granted to Christian Landus bearing date the 22^d day of January 1767. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 26th day of May A.D. 1807 at the particular instant and request of the present owner George Spangler Jun^r - who desired us to make Return of the draught
