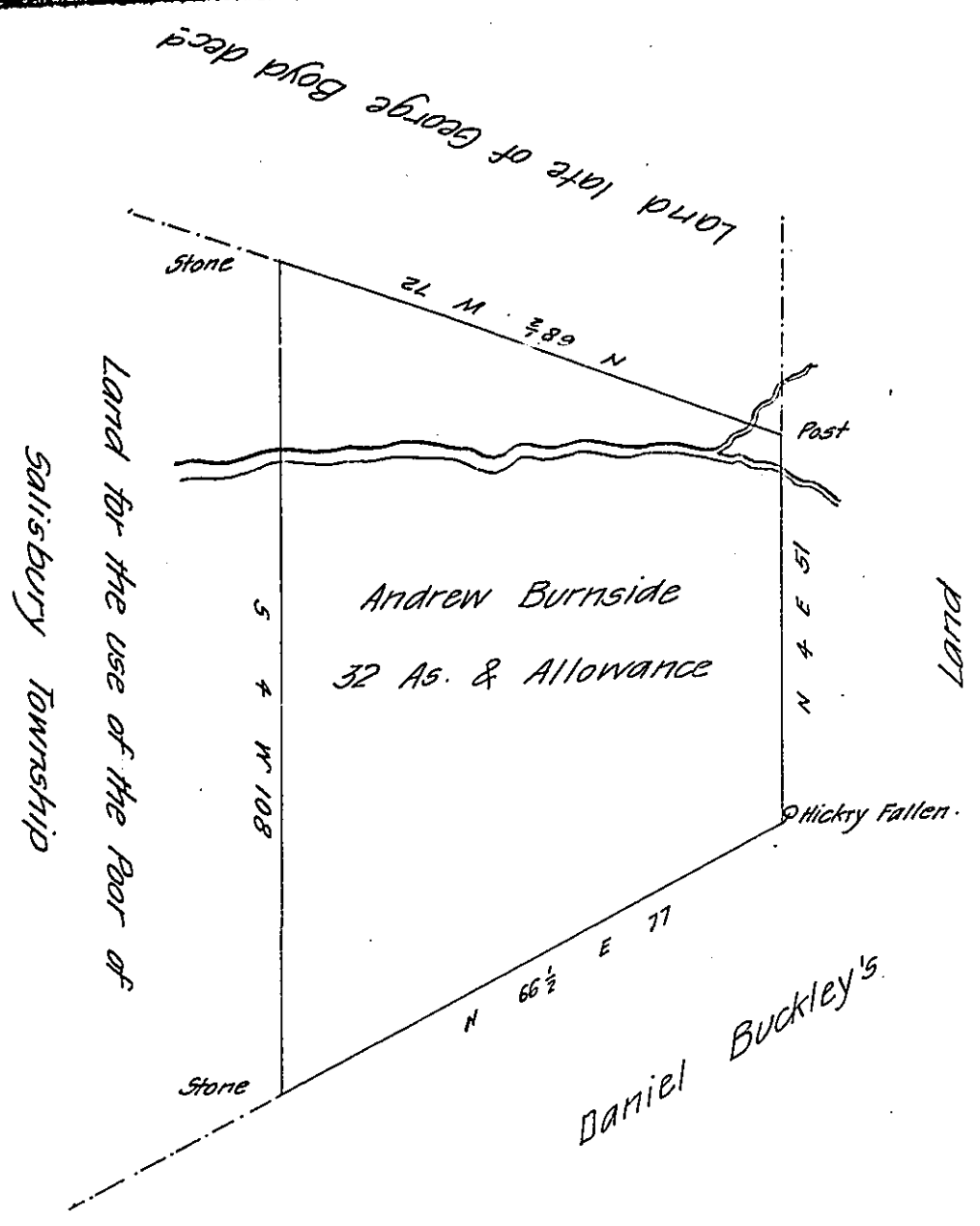

The above draught describes the Land which Thomas Lightfoot D.S. by Virtue of an Application No. 692 dated August 30th 1765 Surveyed to Andrew Burnside soon afterwards for 30 acres & allowance Situate in West Caln Township in the County of Chester and resurveyed the 5th day of March 1801 containing Thirty two Acres & allowance of Six P. Ct. for Roads &c. — The above resurvey sign'd Charles Dilworth D.S. was put into my hands since his decease in Order for return & having examined the same, am of Opinion it may be depended upon.
