



A draught of a piece of land situate in Chanceford township in the county of York containing in the whole as above set forth 51<sup>9</sup>/<sub>100</sub> prs. and allowances the part A within the yellow lines was originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Mathew Adams (in two pieces) dated the 9<sup>th</sup> September A. D. 1788. The part B is a vacancy, containing 2<sup>9</sup>/<sub>100</sub> and allowances which is added to the other at the request of Samuel Bechtel, the present owner. Now on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of December A. D. 1833. I resurveyed the said larger tract and the part B I surveyed at the same time at the request of said Samuel Bechtel the present owner who requested me to make return thereof for confirmation who wishes to patent the same &c.
