



Situate in Lower Chancetown township in the County of York containing within the black lines as above set forth 149.72 perches and the usual allowance &c. Surveyed on the 13th day of June 1828 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Mathes Douglas for 109.72 dated the 21st day of May A. D. 1828 -

That part of the above survey represented by a dotted line and where the letter A is placed in contains about 39.68 perches and is claimed by the heirs of Josiah Wilson decd under an improvement and survey said to have been made in the ^{year} 1801 and conveyed to the said Josiah Wilson by Joseph Peden and wife by their Deed dated 20th April 1810.
