

Containing as above set forth 135⁹⁹ & 16 perches and
allowance. Surveyed the 24th day of August A.D.
1820 in pursuance of a warrant for \$30⁹⁹ granted to
Samuel Gross bearing date the 13th day of June 1820 -

The improvement on the above described tract of land at the time of surveying consisted of a dwelling house, stable, barn Distillery and other out houses with a quantity of cleared land rendering it an actual personal resident settlement with a manifest intention of making it a place of abode and means of supporting a family
