



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York containing as above set forth 22<sup>a</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> perches and the usual allowance of six per cent & surveyed on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December A. D<sup>o</sup> 1814 in pursuance of a warrant for 23<sup>a</sup>, granted to Robert Eibson bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of August A. D<sup>o</sup> 1814. I further beg leave to represent that James McCannless claims the whole of the above described land. In pursuance of a warrant for 300<sup>a</sup> (directed to be surveyed in six pieces or surveys) granted to the said James McCannless bearing date the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June Anno Domini 1788.
