



Situate in Lower Chancford township in the County of York containing as above set forth 12.9 and the usual allowance of 6 per cent &c. Surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1815, in pursuance of a warrant for 13.9 granted to John Bebbey bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1814.

N.B. The improvement on the above described land at the time of surveying were part of a cleared field without any building thereon and that made prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March A. D. 1814.
