



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 27th day of November A.D. 1850 there was surveyed on the 12th day of December A.D. 1850 unto Abraham A. Bartolet the above described tract of land situated in south Manheim township Schuylkill County containing one hundred and ten acres & fifty four perches and allowance of six per cents for Roads & Resurveyed March 1th A.D. 1864. Containing eighty four acres and one hundred and fifteen perches and allowance of six per cents for Road. &c.
