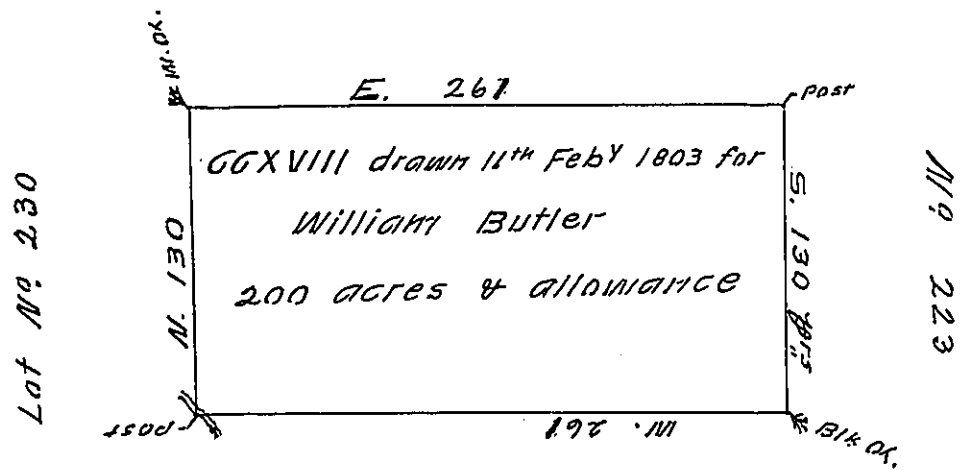

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24 day of February 1785 entitle an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth and by order of the of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive—I have surveyed on the 14th day of October 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land & allowance of six per cent for roads &c No CCXVIII situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany River in Westmoreland County.
