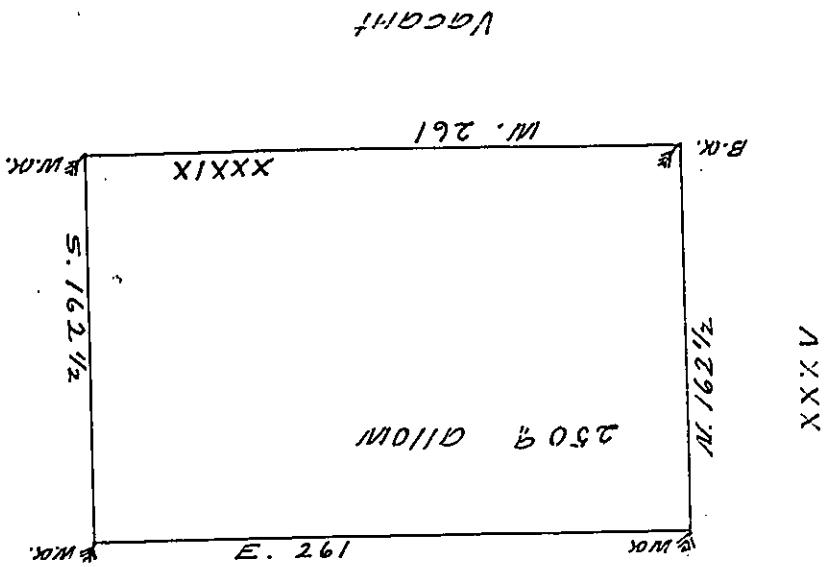

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops by this commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable Executive Council I have surveyed on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785 the above described tract of two hundred & fifty acres of land and allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent for roads &c No XXXIX situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany River in Westmoreland County.
