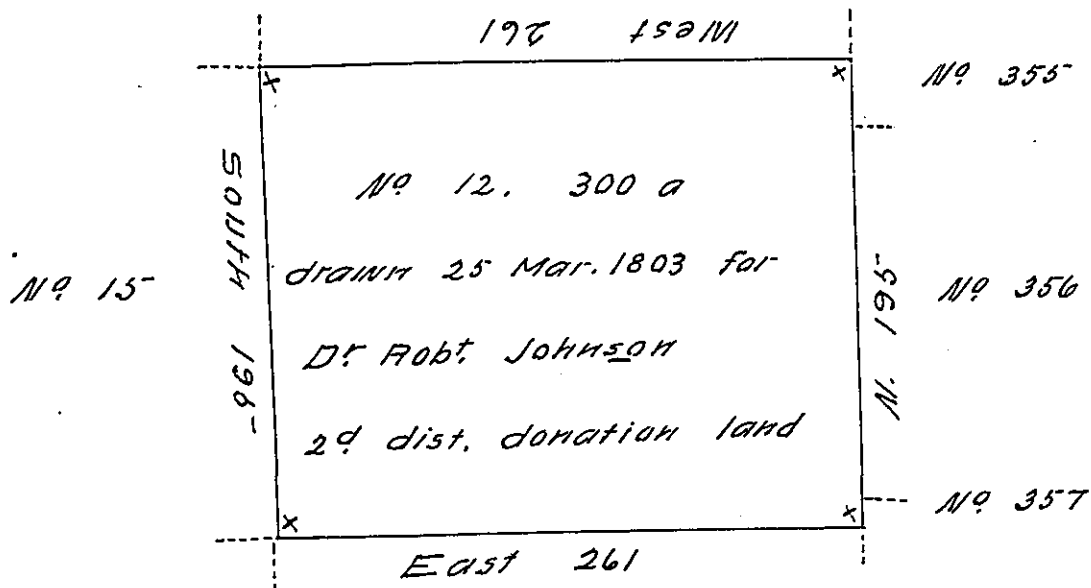

The following certificate was found filed and enclosed with the above draft.

State of Pennsa. ss.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly passed the 24<sup>th</sup> February 1785 there was surveyed a certain Lot No 12 which said lot was drawn for Dr Robert Johnston, the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1803 called, Liberty. Situate in donation district No 2 in \_\_\_\_\_ County, beginning at a corner, thence by lot No 11 East two hundred sixty one perches to a corner, thence by lots No 357 No 356 & No 355, North one hundred ninety five perches to a corner, thence by lot No 13 west two hundred sixty one perches to a corner, and thence by lot No 15 South one hundred ninety five perches to the beginning containing three hundred acres and allowance of six ft. ct. for roads &c. Returned into the Secretary's office the 31<sup>st</sup> March 1803.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Thirtieth day of April 1908
