In pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled "an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops by this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1786 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land and allowance for roads &c. No 1951 situate in district No 2 on the west side of the Allegany river in the county of Westmoreland.
