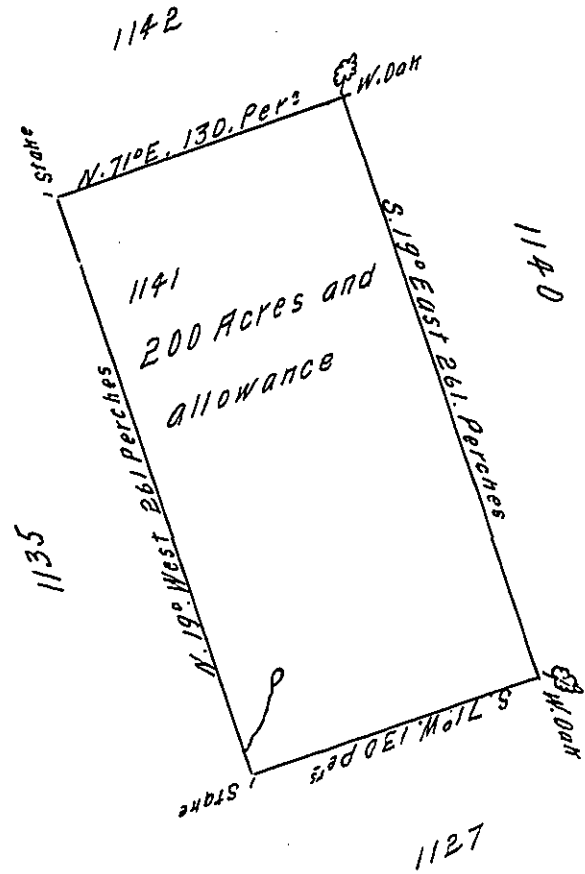


Donation land in District No 6

Lot No MCXLI



Chosen 8th Day of March 1809 by William Falwell and Jane his Wife in lieu of MMCXXIV which has fallen into the State of New York.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the Twenty fourth Day of February 1785. Entitled an Act for Directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth, and by order of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 10 Day of Novembr 1785 the Above described Tract of Land of Two hundred Acres, and Allowence of Six P. Cent. for roads &c. No 1141 situate in District No 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland
