the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 27th day of Sep-
tember 1785 the above Discribed Tract of two Hundred Acres
of Land & allowance of Six P^{ct} for Roads &c Nº DCCCXC Situate
in District Nº 5 on the West side of the Allegany River in the
County of West moreland.
