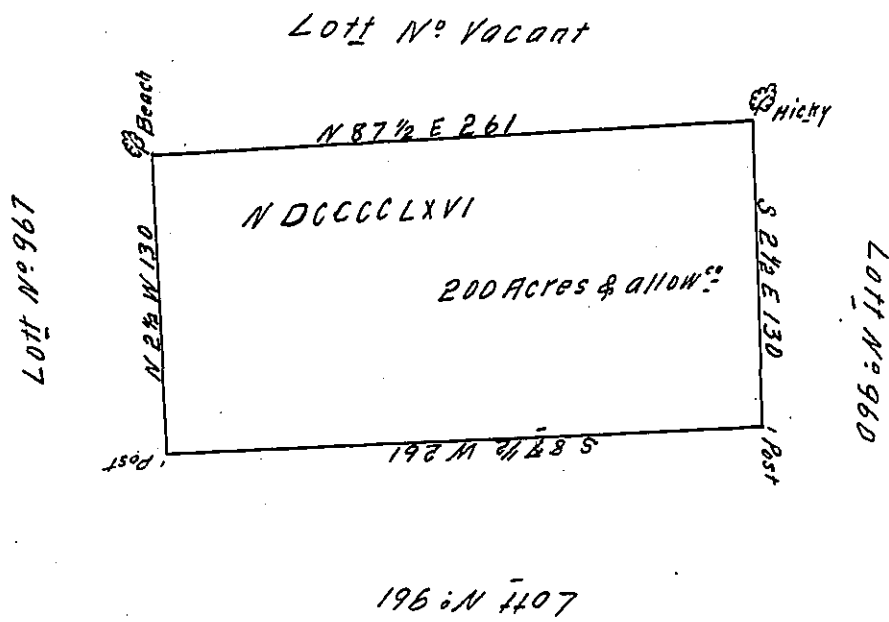

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
 of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of Febru-
 ary 1785 entitled an Act for directing the Mode of distribu-
 ting the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common-
 wealth" and by order of the Surveyor General with the Appro-
 bation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council" I have Surveyed on
 the 5 day of October 1785 the above discribed Tract of two
 Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &
 N° DCCCCLXVI. Situate in District N° 5 on the West side of the
 Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
