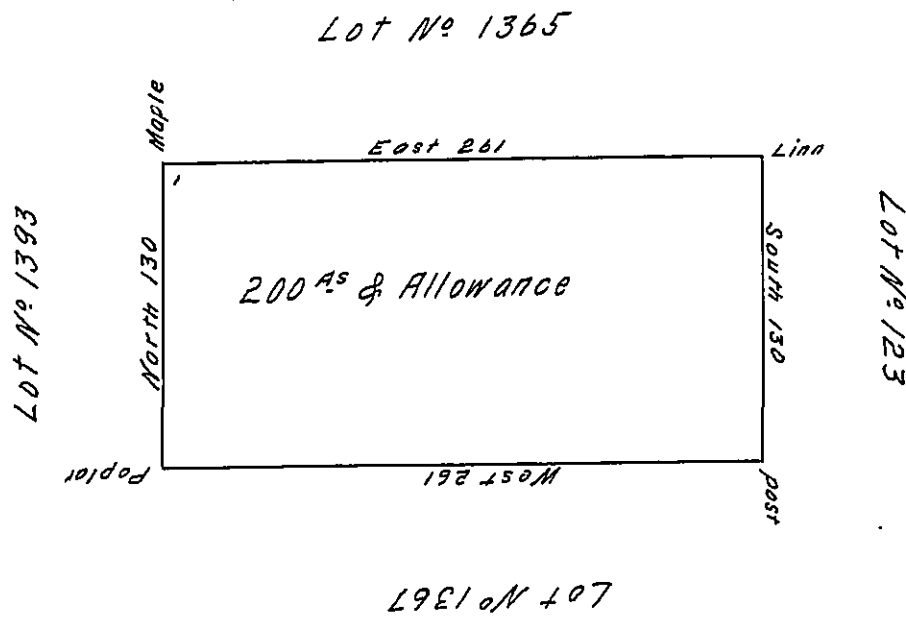

Intituled an Act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Do-
nation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth &
by order of the Surveyor Gen^l With the Approbation of the
Hon^l the Executi^{ve} Council I have Surveyed on the 2nd day of
Aug^t 1785 the Above Described tract of Land two Hundred
Acres & Allow^{ce} of 6 P Cent for Roads &c N^o MCCCLXVI. situate on
the west side of the Allegeny River in the County of Westmorland.
