

the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785,
entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Dona-
tion Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by
order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon-
orable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the
6th day of October 1785, the above described Tract of two hun-
dred acres of land, and allowance of six per cent. for roads,
so. No. 1522 situate in District No. 8 on the west side of the
Allegany river, in the county of Westmoreland.
