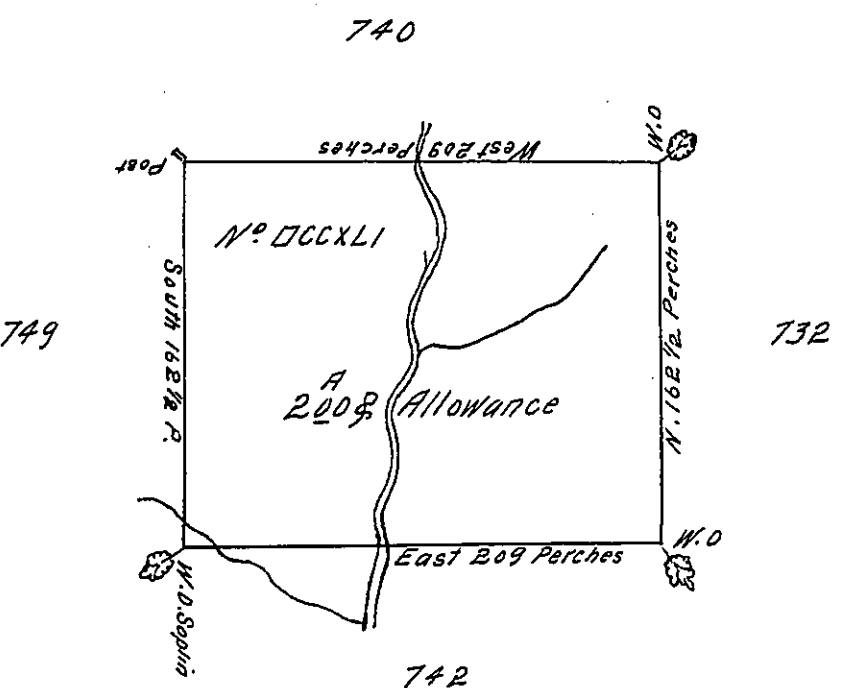


Drawn on the 17<sup>th</sup>

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly  
of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1785  
entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation  
"Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth" and by order of  
the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive  
Council I have Survey'd on the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1785 the above  
described tract of two hundred Acres of Land & Allow<sup>ce</sup> of six Pct  
for Roads &c. Nº DCCXLI situate in District Nº 4 on the west side  
of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
