


Donation-Land, in District No. 6

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of
February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of
distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this
'Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the
Approbation of the Honorable the Executive-Council, I have
surveyed, on the Seventh Day of December 1785, the above
described Tract of five hundred Acres of Land, and Allow-
ance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c. No. 120 situate in Dist-
trict No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County
of Westmoreland.
