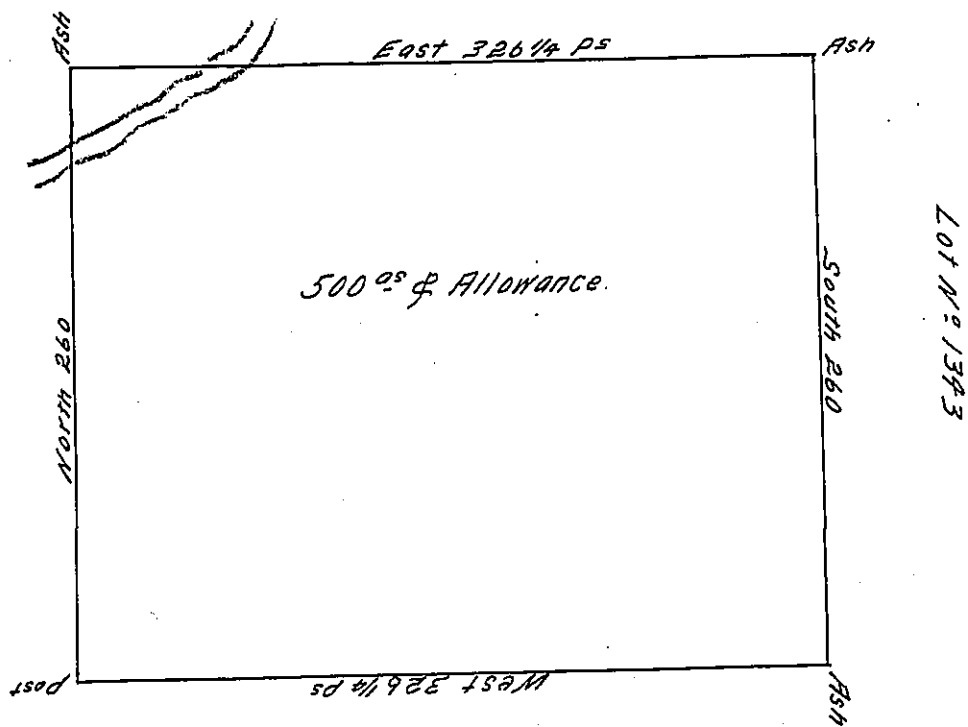

Intituled An Act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed On the 22<sup>d</sup> day of July 1785 the Above Described tract of five Hundred Acres & Allow: of 6 P Cent for Roads &c. No CXXIX situate in District No 7 on the West side of the Allegeny River In the County Of Westmorland.
