 Six per Cent. for George S. Hicks, and Alexander W. Hicks.
 Being a part of a larger Tract of Land as marked by
poped lines, containing 500 acres & all. which was Sur-
 vey'd the 7th June 1837 by J. Gay D.S. In Pursuance of a
 warrant Granted to John Millinger dated the 20th day of Feb-
 ruary 1788. Situate on a branch of Jacobs Creek in South Hunt-
 ington Township and in the County of Westmoreland:
