



A draught of a tract of land situate in Spring township Centre County containing three hundred and forty seven acres thirty two perches and the allow^e of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for roads &c surveyed for Francis Nichols Nov^r. 20th. 1776 as appears by a draught remaining in my office resurveyed agreeably to the old lines in pursuance of orders from the Sur^v. Gen^l. and his warrant dated Dec^r. 5th. 1774. done May 19th. 1804.

Note - the part marked (A) is included in a survey made for George Gabriel on his app^l dated April 3^d. 1769 the part marked (B) in a survey made for Hugh Means on his warrant dated Dec^r. 7th. 1774, and the part marked (C) in a survey made for Benjamin Davis on a warrant dated July 1st. 1784
