John Wells in January last obtained a Warrt. for 600 as in Chester County adjoining to Gibbons 1200 on the south of Gibbons's sd Wells desires such a Quantity if less than 600 as. as will include an Improvmt^e he has made there John Taylor some time says it was Surveyed to Isaac self & some time says ~~it~~ its his own. But Ezekiel Harlan who was chain man in Surveying the sd Selfs Land says they began to lay out a Tract there but Isaac Taylor left it & laid out Self's Land in another place & Harlan advised Wells to settle there & told him it was vacant Land.
