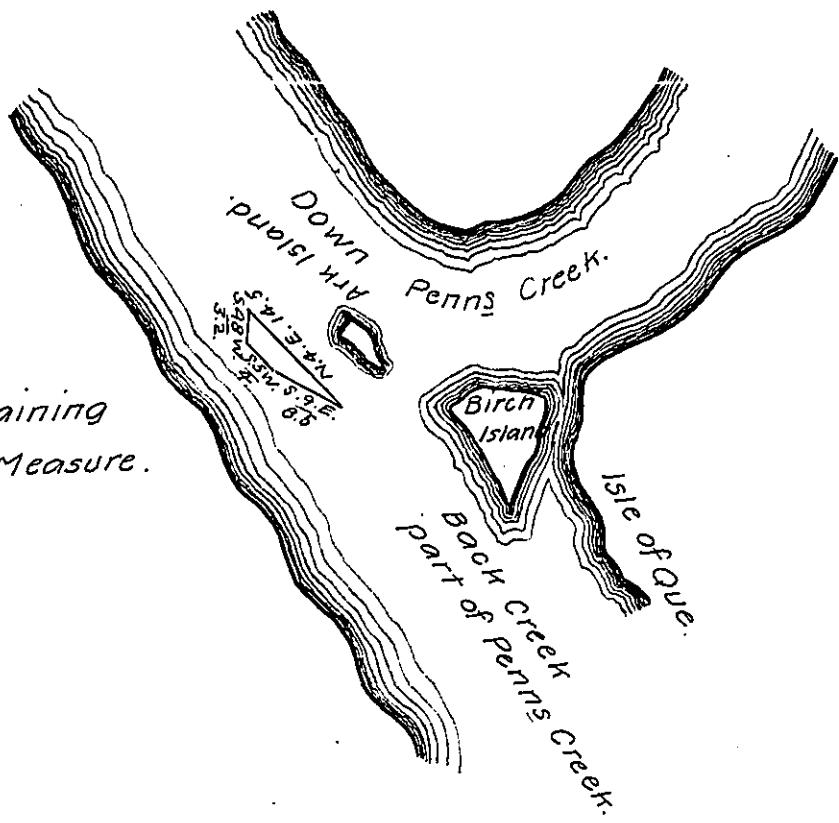


Goose Island containing
