



In Pursuance of a warrant dated the thirtieth day of September Anno Dom: 1762 Granted to Samuel Bell for Surveying one hundred Acres of land in any part of the Province of Pennsylvania in Right of the Pennsylvania Land Company in London, Surveyed the 28th day of April 1788 for Garret Godshalk the above Tract of land situate in Lower Salford township in Montgomery County Adjoyning Skippack Creek Containing forty eight Acres & 145 perches with the usual allowance of six p^t. Cent. for Roads &c. in part of sd 100 Acres.
