



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Tyrone Township in Cumberland County containing one Hundred Acres and the Usual allowance of Six Cent. for Roads; Surveyed Feb<sup>y</sup>. 19<sup>th</sup> 1766 for Samuel Bell in Pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietaries, Bearing Date Sept<sup>r</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> Anno Domini 1762.

N.B. The above Warrant was granted to Samuel Bell in consequence of a conveyance from Jacob Cooper, Samuel Shoemaker and Joshua Howell of part of an old right belonging to the Pennsylvania London Company Dated Sept<sup>r</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> 1762.
