Whereas Hance George Schutz and Matthias Ringer having obtained a Warrant for five hundred acres of Land on the West side of the River Schuikil where Peter Bizailon formerly Dwelt have consented that Andrew Suckler should have a part of the same There was surveyd and laid out to the said Andrew Suckler on the sixth day of the third month 1718 a Part of the said Land Situate as aforesaid Beginning at a Post by the said River at a Corner of John Woolf Millers Land Thence by the said Land south West three hundred and thirty fches to a post Then south East by a Line of Marked trees ~~etc~~ Eighty two perches to a post Then North East ~~by North East~~ by Matthias Ringers Land three hundred forty six fches to the side of Schuikil Then up the same on several courses ~~et~~ to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred seventy five acres.
