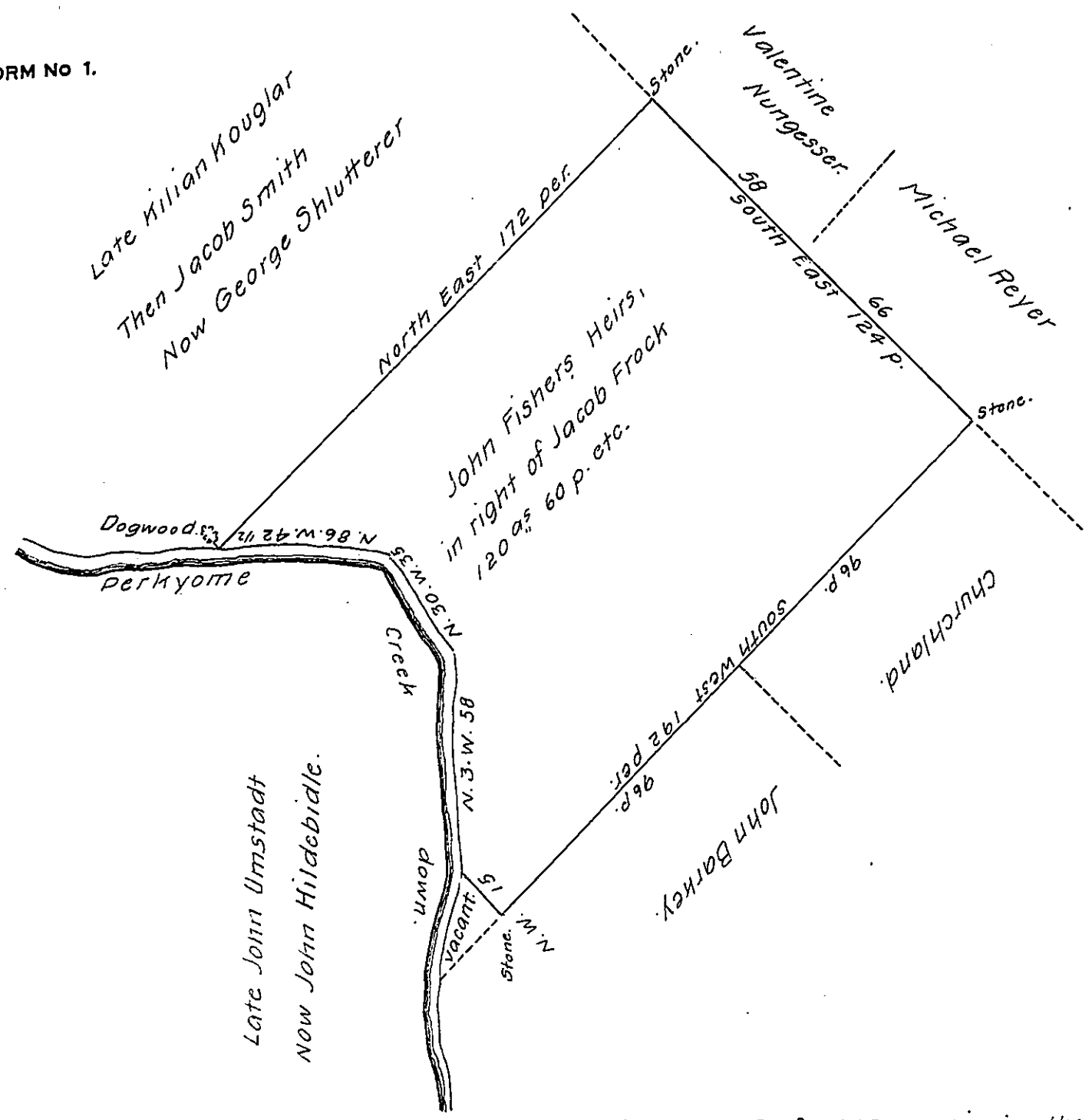


FORM NO 1.



A Draught of a tract of Land, Situate in Upper Solford Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania Containing One Hundred and Twenty acres and 60 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent. for Roads. That was formerly Surveyed unto Jacob Froch In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries of this Province --- Dated at Philadelphia, on the 29th July, Anno 1734.

The said Jacob Froch by his Deed Poll dated the 10th March 1742 Sold and assigned his Right to the same, unto John Fisher

Now Resurveyed for the said John Fishers Heirs

On the 18th Day of May Anno 1772

By Order of the Surveyor General

Notand... The small Piece left Vaccant *Dr David Shultze.* on the Lower End on the Creek was left out with Consent of the Parties and agreed and intended to be Taken up Shortly by John Barkey.
