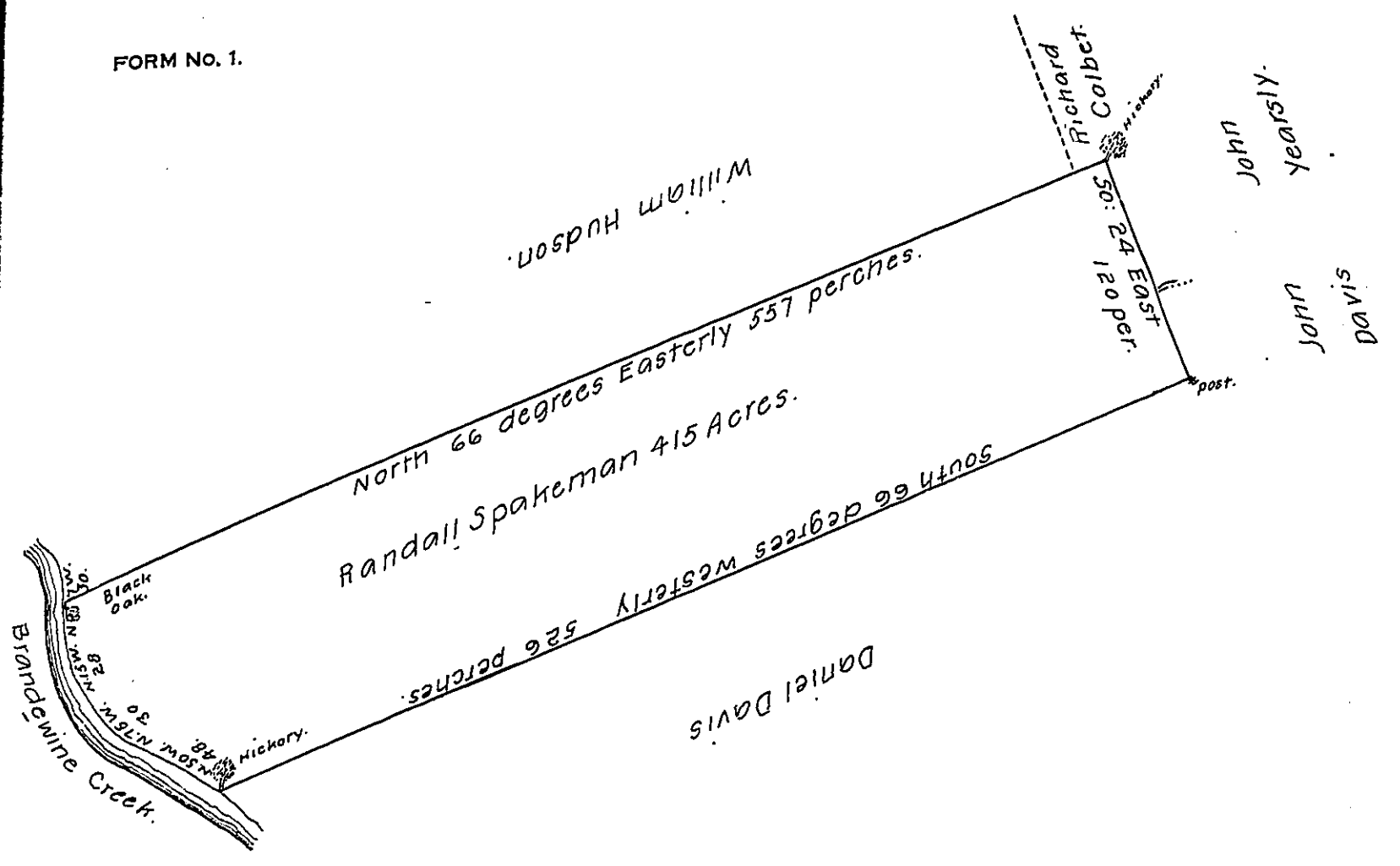

 at a post being the Corner of Daniel Davis his Land thence South sixty six
 degrees westerly 526 perches to A Hickory by Brandywine Creek then up sd
 Creek North 50 degrees westerley 48 perches thence North 75 degrees Westly 30
 perches thence North 15^{deg} wes- Twenty Eight perches thence north seven
 deg: west 30 perches to a black oak thence North sixty six deg: Eastly 557
 perches in the Line of William Hudson & Richard Colbet to a Hickory thence
 South 24 deg: Easterly in ye Line of John Yearsley & John Davis 120 perches
 to the first Mentioned post containing four hundred & fifteen Acres.

Resurveid the 27th of ye 10th month 1701.
