



The above is a Draught of a Survey made June 22^d 1827, for the Administrators of William Hawkins Dec^d in pursuance of a Certificate from the Commissioners, of the Counties of Monongalia, Youghiogania, and Ohio, to W^m Hawkins, assignee of Robert M^r Haim, for 400 Acres. dated Feb^y 17th 1780, I have not seen the Certificate, but the Oath of Robert Woods S.O.C. is in my possession it appears from his Oath, that he made a Survey on the above land, July 19th 1780. Stating it to be situate in Ohio County, V^o on the South fork of Buffalo Creek, which is now Donegall Township Washington County on the South fork of Buffalo Creek Containing three hundred and ninety six Acres, and 61 perches Strict measure: ~~and seventy three Acres and 153 perches and Allowance of six per Cent for highways, there is~~ an actual Settlement and improvement on the land, some of it appears old, but how long I know not.
