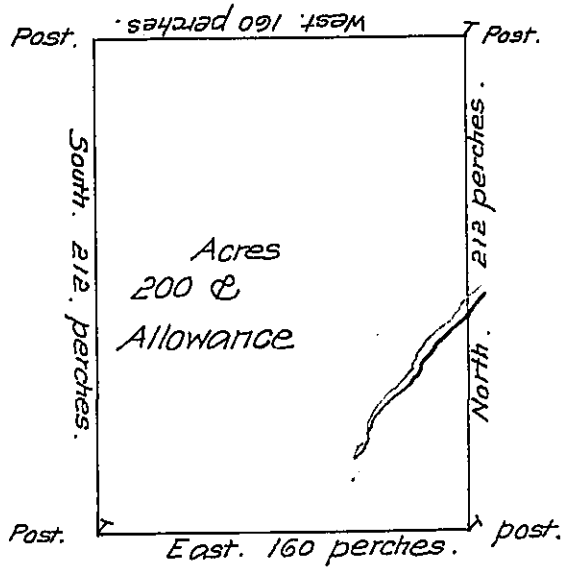

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein Mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of office of John Lutens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783. The above tract of land containing two hundred acres and Allowance of Six P<sup>ct</sup> Cent for roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
