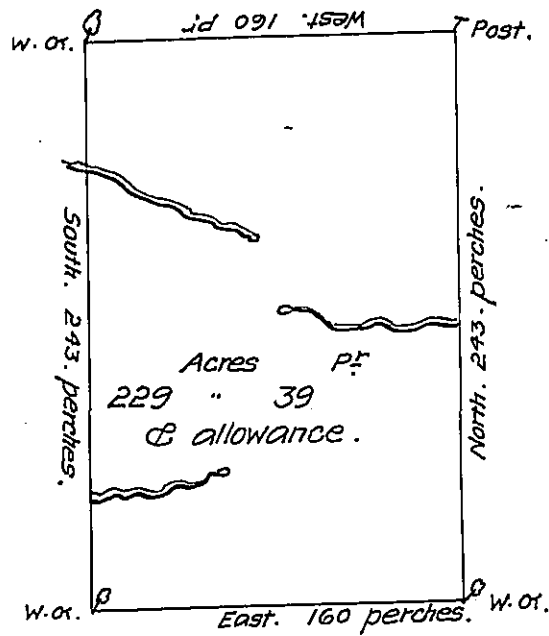


Part of District No 3.
