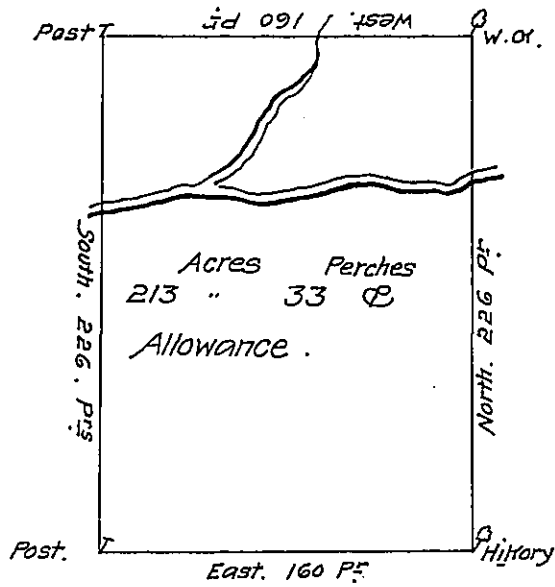

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein Mentioned and by virtue of a commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor Generall for the State of Pennsylvania to Me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the Above tract of land Containing two hundred thirteen Acres and thirty three Perches with allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1783 by
