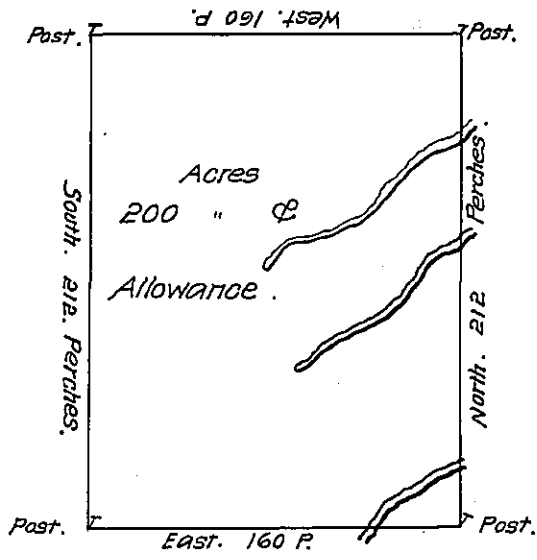

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of an Commission Under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783. The Above tract of land containing two hundred Acres and Allowance of Six P<sup>r</sup> Cent for Roads &c. Was Surveyed On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1785 by
