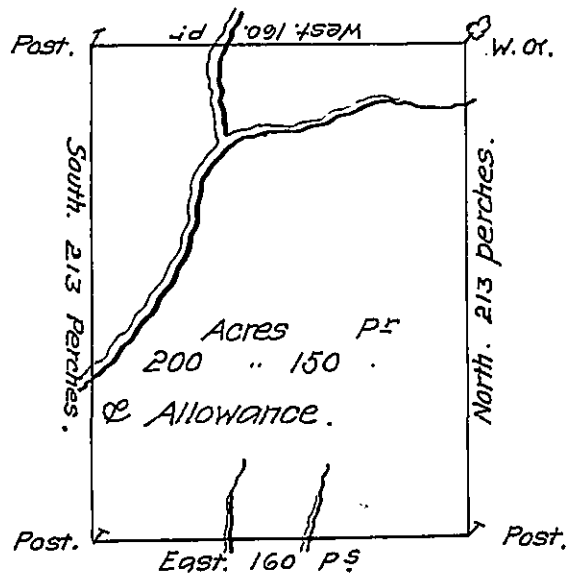

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed March the ~~first~~ for the Sale of certain lands therein Mentioned And by Virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lutens Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1783 the Above Tract containing two hundred ~~and~~ Acres and one hundred and fifty perches & the Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of June 1785 by
