 vised Said Moiety to his heirs, who conveyed to James Johnston the Present Owner, the other
 Moiety William Sloan devised to his heirs who conveyed to John Sloan & Charles Taggart the Present owri-
 ers. No 1. Represented by the Broken lines is a Draft of a tract of land Surveyed for John M^o Hinley in pursuance
 of A Warrant dated the 7th day of April 1796. This tract Interferes Eight Acres & forty Nine perches With the William
 Sloan tract. John M^o Hinley conveyed to Thomas Johnston who conveyed to James Johnston the present owner.
