



The above is a draught of a Survey Executed the 20th day of Oct^r 1812 for Thomas L. Birch, in pursuance of a warrant Granted to William Dawson dated Feb^r 9th 1785 latterly Allegheny County and Situate formerly in Robinson Township, Washington County, now in First Moon Township Beaver County, adjoining lands of Edward Ward George Wallace and Others, Containing 337 Acres and 112 perches and Allowance of Six per Cent.
