



A Draft of a Tract or Piece of Land situate in Guilford Township in the County of Franklin Containing one hundred and twenty three Acres and seventy six Perches and the Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads &c? being a Part of a Tract of 329 Acres & 33 Perches & Allowance formerly survey'd in pursuance of an Order of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 3084. granted to William Vanlear (since deceased) bearing Date the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1767 and being such a proportion of the said Tract, as it is alleged William Vanlear, his eldest Son, is intitled to by the last Will and Testament of the Said Father William Vanlear deceased. Survey'd and laid off the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1792.
